(1) In implementing the single, statewide computer-assisted student advising system required under 17 section 240.2099, Florida Statutes, the Board of Regents and 18 19 the State Board of Community Colleges may: 20 (a) Perform all things necessary to secure letters of 21 patent, copyrights, and trademarks on any work products and 22 enforce their rights with respect thereto. 23 (b) Enter into binding agreements with organizations, corporations, or government entities to license, lease, 24 25 assign, or otherwise give written consent to any person, firm, 26 corporation, or agency for the use of the single, statewide, 27 computer-assisted student advising system and collect 28 royalties or any other consideration that the boards find 29 proper. 30 (c) Sell any such work products and execute all

instruments necessary to consummate the sale.

(2) All or a portion of the proceeds derived from activities authorized under this section may be expended for the costs incurred in developing and maintaining the single, statewide computer-assisted student advising system. Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law. SENATE SUMMARY Authorizes the Board of Regents and the State Board of Community Colleges to secure and enforce patents, enter into various license and lease agreements, and sell work products as part of the duties of the boards in developing and implementing a single, statewide computer-assisted student advising system. Provides for the use of proceeds derived from much activities the use of proceeds derived from such activities.
