23	residents. These programs have maintained the highest
24	practicable level of good health and have the potential to
25	reduce the incidence of preventable illnesses among long-stay
26	residents of nursing homes, thereby increasing the quality of
27	care for residents and reducing the number of lawsuits against
28	nursing homes. Such models are operated at no cost to the
29	state.
30	(2) The Agency for Health Care Administration shall
31	develop a pilot project in selected counties to demonstrate

1	the effect of assigning skilled and trained medical personnel

23	(c) Frequent onsite visits to the resident;
24	(d) Early detection of medical or quality problems
25	that have the potential to lead to adverse outcomes and

27	(e) Close communication with regulatory staff;
28	(f) Immediate investigation of resident
29	quality-of-care complaints and communication and cooperation
