At such 4 time as the amount on deposit in the Resident Protection Trust 5 Fund is less than \$1,000,000\$ (\$500,000), the agency may adopt rules to establish a rate which may not exceed \$10 per bed. 6 7 The rate per bed shall revert back to the minimum rate per bed when the amount on deposit in the Resident Protection Trust 8 9 Fund reaches\$1,000,000\$, except that any rate 10 established by rule shall remain in effect until such time as the rate has been equally required for each license issued 11 12 under this part. Any amount in the fund in excess of 13 \$2,000,000<del>\$800,000</del> shall revert to the Health Care Trust Fund 14 and may not be expended without prior approval of the 15 Legislature. The agency may prorate the annual license fee 16 for those licenses which it issues under this part for less 17 than 1 year. Funds generated by license fees collected in accordance with this section shall be deposited in the 18 following manner: 19

- (a) The basic license fee collected shall be deposited in the Health Care Trust Fund, established for the sole purpose of carrying out this part. When the balance of the account established in the Health Care Trust Fund for the deposit of fees collected as authorized under this section exceeds one-third of the annual cost of regulation under this part, the excess shall be used to reduce the licensure fees in the next year.
- (b) The resident protection fee collected shall be deposited in the Resident Protection Trust Fund for the sole purpose of paying, in accordance with the provisions of s. 400.063, for the appropriate alternate placement, care, and

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treatment of a resident removed from a nursing home facility on a temporary, emergency basis or for the maintenance and care of residents in a nursing home facility pending removal and alternate placement.
