A bill to be entitled  
An act relating to Marion County; prohibiting  
watercraft within specified areas of Lake Weir  
from proceeding at greater than "no-wake"  
speeds; requiring the board of county  
commissioners to erect signs; directing the  
Marion County Sheriff to enforce the  
prohibition; providing penalties; providing an  
effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Within 500 feet of the shoreline of Grass  
Island (state identification 606121) watercraft must proceed  
at idle speed. The Marion County Commissioners shall erect  
signs within the area designated by this act; such signs must  
contain the prohibition "NO WAKE" and the statement "VIOLATORS  
WILL BE PROSECUTED." Violation of this act constitutes a  
noncriminal violation and is punishable as provided in section  
775.083, Florida Statutes. The Sheriff of Marion County is  
responsible for enforcing this act.

Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2001.
