Amendment (with title amendment)

Remove from the bill: Everything after the enacting clause
and insert in lieu thereof:

Section 1. Subsection (3) is added to section 381.003, Florida Statutes, to read:

381.003 Communicable disease and AIDS prevention and control.--

(3) The department shall by rule adopt the blood-borne pathogen standard set forth in subpart Z of 29 C.F.R. part 1910, as amended by Pub. L. No. 106-430, which shall be applicable to all public sector employers. The department shall compile and maintain a list of existing needleless systems and sharps with engineered sharps injury protection that shall be available to assist employers, including the department and the Department of Corrections, in complying with the applicable requirements of the blood-borne pathogen standard. The list may be developed from existing sources of information, including, but not limited to, the United States
