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1 must be the supervisor or command officer of a member or 2 members who have such responsibilities; provided, however, 3 administrative support personnel, including, but not limited 4 to, those whose primary duties and responsibilities are in 5 accounting, purchasing, legal, and personnel, shall not be 6 included;

7 (b) The member must be employed as a firefighter and be certified, or required to be certified, in compliance with 8 9 s. 633.35 and be employed solely within the fire department of 10 the employer or agency of state government. In addition, the member's duties and responsibilities must include on-the-scene 11 12 fighting of fires or direct supervision of firefighting units, 13 or the member must be the supervisor or command officer of a member or members who have such responsibilities; provided, 14 15 however, administrative support personnel, including, but not limited to, those whose primary duties and responsibilities 16 17 are in accounting, purchasing, legal, and personnel, shall not be included; 18

(c) The member must be employed as a correctional 19 officer and be certified, or required to be certified, in 20 compliance with s. 943.1395. In addition, the member's 21 primary duties and responsibilities must be the custody, and 22 physical restraint when necessary, of prisoners or inmates 23 24 within a prison, jail, or other criminal detention facility, 25 or while on work detail outside the facility, or while being transported; or the member must be the supervisor or command 26 27 officer of a member or members who have such responsibilities; provided, however, administrative support personnel, 28 29 including, but not limited to, those whose primary duties and 30 responsibilities are in accounting, purchasing, legal, and 31 personnel, shall not be included; however, wardens and

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1 assistant wardens, as defined by rule, shall participate in 2 the Special Risk Class;

(d) The member must be employed by a licensed Advance 3 4 Life Support (ALS) or Basic Life Support (BLS) employer as an 5 emergency medical technician or a paramedic and be certified in compliance with s. 401.27. In addition, the member's 6 7 primary duties and responsibilities must include on-the-scene 8 emergency medical care. However, administrative support 9 personnel, including, but not limited to, those whose primary 10 responsibilities are in accounting, purchasing, legal, and 11 personnel, shall not be included;

12 (e) The member must be employed as a community-based 13 correctional probation officer and be certified, or required to be certified, in compliance with s. 943.1395. In addition, 14 15 the member's primary duties and responsibilities must be the 16 supervised custody, surveillance, control, investigation, and 17 counseling of assigned inmates, probationers, parolees, or community controllees within the community; or the member must 18 be the supervisor of a member or members who have such 19 20 responsibilities. Administrative support personnel, including, 21 but not limited to, those whose primary duties and responsibilities are in accounting, purchasing, legal 22 services, and personnel management, shall not be included; 23 24 however, probation and parole circuit and deputy circuit 25 administrators shall participate in the Special Risk Class; or (f) The member must be employed in one of the 26 27 following classes and must spend at least 75 percent of his or 28 her time performing duties which involve contact with patients or inmates in a correctional or forensic facility or 29 30 institution: 1. Dietitian (class codes 5203 and 5204). 31
