29	and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution, except as

1. With the express written consent of the individual 1 2 or the individual's legally authorized representative; 2. In a medical emergency, but only to the extent 3 4 necessary to protect the health or life of the individual; or 5 3. By order of a court upon a showing of good cause. 6 7 This paragraph is subject to the Open Government Sunset Review Act of 1995 in accordance with s. 119.15, and shall stand 8 9 repealed on October 2, 2006, unless reviewed and saved from repeal through reenactment by the Legislature. 10 11 Section 2. The Legislature finds that it is a public 12 necessity that personal identifying information that is 13 contained in records relating to an individual's personal 14 health or eligibility for paratransit services under the Americans with Disabilities Act and that is made or received 15 16 by local government entities or their service providers be held confidential and exempt from public disclosure. The 17 Legislature finds that this exemption is needed to protect 18 19 information that is of a sensitive personal nature concerning 20 individuals. Every person has an expectation of and a right to privacy in all matters concerning his or her personal health 21 22 or physical condition. For this reason, such matters are traditionally private and confidential concerns between an 23 individual and an individual's health care provider. 24 Therefore, the individual's expectation and right to privacy 25 26 in all matters relating to his or her personal health and 27 eligibility for paratransit services that are provided by 28 local government or its service providers necessitates this 29 exemption. 30 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2001. 31
