A bill to be entitled  
An act relating to the size of individual  
containers of malt beverages; amending s.  
563.06, F.S.; removing current restrictions on  
containers under a specified size; providing an  
effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (6) of section 563.06, Florida  
Statutes, is amended to read:

563.06 Malt beverages; imprint on individual  
container; size of containers; exemptions.--

(6) All malt beverages packaged in individual  
containers sold or offered for sale by vendors at retail in  
this state shall be in individual containers containing no  
more than ~~only 8, 12, 16, or~~ 32 ounces of such malt beverages;  
provided, however, that nothing contained in this section  
shall affect malt beverages packaged in bulk or in kegs or in  
barrels or in any individual container containing 1 gallon or  
more of such malt beverage regardless of individual container  
type.

Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2001.

SENATE SUMMARY

Allows malt beverages to be sold in any size individual  
container of 32 ounces or less.
