The Committee on Health, Aging and Long-Term Care recommended the following amendment:

**Senate Amendment**

On page 6, line 5, after the period,

insert: The Legislature finds that the risk-based capital reports provide early warning signs that may necessitate corrective action before serious financial problems arise and such activity is a public benefit. Providing confidentiality to such records and proceedings enables the health maintenance organizations to reduce risk to members of the health maintenance organization and encourages the health maintenance organization to be more open and frank in the information so provided, without the attendant fear that honest and truthful exchange of information will result in the public dissemination of information that could be used to harm the health maintenance organization and its members.
