A law enforcement officer 27 may stop any person operating or riding upon a motorcycle 28 without wearing protective headgear securely fastened upon his 29 or her head and may ask that person to show proof of compliance with the insurance requirements of this paragraph 30 when a valid insurance decal is not affixed to the license 31

plate of the motorcycle. If that person does not show proof of compliance he or she is subject to punishment in accordance with subsection (6). Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2001. SENATE SUMMARY Requires valid insurance decals on license plates of motorcycles whose riders do not wear protective headgear. Authorizes law enforcement officers to stop persons riding without protective headgear to show proof of compliance with insurance requirements when a valid insurance decal is not affixed to the license plate.
