A board or profession regulated by the department may authorize the transfer of funds from the operating fund 8 9 account to the unlicensed activity account of that profession 10 if the operating fund account is not in a deficit and has a reasonable cash balance. The department shall make direct 11 12 charges to this fund by profession and shall not allocate 13 indirect overhead. The department shall seek board advice 14 regarding enforcement methods and strategies prior to 15 expenditure of funds; however, the department may, without 16 board advice, allocate funds to cover the costs of continuing 17 education compliance monitoring under s. 455.2177. The department shall directly credit, by profession, revenues 18 received from the department's efforts to enforce licensure 19 provisions, including revenues received from fines collected 20 21 under s. 455.2177. The department shall include all financial and statistical data resulting from unlicensed activity 22 enforcement and from continuing education compliance 23 24 monitoring as separate categories in the quarterly management report provided for in s. 455.219. The department shall not 25 charge the account of any profession for the costs incurred on 26 27 behalf of any other profession. For an unlicensed activity 28 account, a balance which remains at the end of a renewal cycle may, with concurrence of the applicable board and the 29 30 department, be transferred to the operating fund account of 31 that profession.
