Section 106.0706, Florida Statutes, is 20 created to read: 106.0706 Electronic filing of campaign treasurer's 21 22 reports; confidentiality of personal identification numbers and computer security algorithms .-- All personal identification 23 numbers of, and all computer security algorithms required to 24 maintain the security of information submitted or received 25 26 through, the electronic filing system for campaign treasurer's reports established under s. 106.0705 and held by the division 27 28 are confidential and exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), 29 Art. I of the State Constitution. This section is subject to the Open Government Sunset Review Act of 1995 in accordance 30

unless reviewed and saved from repeal through reenactment by the Legislature.

Section 2. The Legislature finds that it is a public necessity to exempt from public records requirements all personal identification numbers of, and all computer security algorithms required to maintain the security of information submitted or received through, the electronic filing system for campaign treasurer's reports established under s. 106.0705, Florida Statutes, and held by the Division of Elections, because release of such information could invite criminal activity, such as unauthorized access to the electronic filing system. Such unauthorized access could affect the integrity of the information submitted and filed. The Legislature also finds that the above exemption protects the security of campaign treasurer's reports and the security of the electronic filing system.

Section 3. This act shall take effect on the same date that House Bill 273 or similar legislation creating s. 106.0705, Florida Statutes, to provide for electronic filing of campaign treasurer's reports, takes effect, if such legislation is adopted in the same legislative session or an extension thereof.
