On page 1, lines 20 through 24,
remove from the bill: all of said lines

and insert in lieu thereof: education participation requirements, if the eligible dependent child or eligible teenage participant has been identified either as a habitual truant, pursuant to s. 228.041(28), or as a dropout, pursuant to s. 228.041(29). For a student who has been identified as a habitual truant, the temporary cash assistance must be reinstated after a subsequent grading period in which the child has substantially improved the child's attendance. For a student who has been identified as a dropout, the temporary cash assistance must be reinstated after the student enrolls in a public school, receives a high school diploma or its equivalency, enrolls in preparation for the General Educational Development Tests, or enrolls in other educational activities approved by the district school board.
