24	ex-husband of Carmen Pena and father of minor children
25	Katherine Pena, Richard Pena, and Johammes Pena, and
26	WHEREAS, on October 21, 1990, the vehicle being driven
27	by Carmen Pena left the roadway on which she was traveling and
28	hit a dangerously large drop-off as she was attempting to
29	return to the road, which caused Carmen Pena to lose control

3	WHEREAS, on July 15, 1991, a complaint was filed on
4	behalf of the Estates of Carmen Pena, Katherine Pena, and
5	Richard Pena, and on behalf of the surviving father, Jose
6	Pena, and on behalf of the surviving son, Johammes Pena, and
7	WHEREAS, in the complaint, the City of Hialeah was
8	charged with failing to properly inspect and maintain the

16	in the amount of \$187,500 for the loss of his mother, Carmen
17	Pena; for Jose Pena in the amount of \$78,395.84 for the loss

19	of \$242,199.65 for the loss of his son, Richard Pena; and for
20	Jose Pena in the amount of \$784,570.04 for the Estate of
