22 to conform to the repeal of s. 290.0075, F.S.;
23 repealing s. 448.24(2)(d), F.S., to conform to
24 the repeal of chapter 442, F.S.

26 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

27

28 Section 1. Subsection (3) of section 17.43, Florida
29 Statutes, is repealed.

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1 Reviser's note.--The cited subsection, which
2 relates to termination of the Comptroller's
3 Federal Equitable Sharing Trust Fund, effective
4 July 1, 2002, was expressly repealed by s. 2,
5 ch. 99-84, Laws of Florida, effective November
6 4, 2000. Since the subsection was not repealed
7 by a "current session" of the Legislature, it
8 may be omitted from the Florida Statutes 2001
9 only through a reviser's bill duly enacted by
10 the Legislature. See s. 11.242(5)(b) and (i).

11
12 Section 2. Subsection (3) of section 20.2553, Florida
13 Statutes, is repealed.

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15 Reviser's note.--The cited subsection, which
16 relates to termination of the Federal Law
17 Enforcement Trust Fund within the Department of
18 Environmental Protection, effective July 1,
19 2002, was expressly repealed by s. 2, ch.
20 99-109, Laws of Florida, effective November 4,
21 2000. Since the subsection was not repealed by
22 a "current session" of the Legislature, it may
23 be omitted from the Florida Statutes 2001 only
24 through a reviser's bill duly enacted by the
25 Legislature. See s. 11.242(5)(b) and (i).

27 Section 3. Section 61.182, Florida Statutes, is
28 repealed.

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30 Reviser's note.--The cited section, which
31 relates to the Child Support Depository Trust

1 Fund, was expressly repealed by s. 18, ch.
2 99-205, Laws of Florida, effective July 1,
3 2000. Since the section was not repealed by a
4 "current session" of the Legislature, it may be
5 omitted from the Florida Statutes 2001 only
6 through a reviser's bill duly enacted by the
7 Legislature. See s. 11.242(5)(b) and (i).

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9 Section 4. Subsection (2) of section 206.9825, Florida
10 Statutes, is repealed.

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12 Reviser's note.--The cited subsection, which
13 relates to the aviation fuel tax rate for air
14 carriers making the election pursuant to s.
15 212.0598, expired pursuant to its own terms,
16 effective July 1, 2000.

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18 Section 5. Section 240.3835, Florida Statutes, is
19 repealed.

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21 Reviser's note.--The cited section, which
22 relates to the Community College Capital
23 Facilities Matching Trust Fund, was expressly
24 repealed by s. 13, ch. 99-243, Laws of Florida,
25 effective July 1, 2000. Since the section was
26 not repealed by a "current session" of the
27 Legislature, it may be omitted from the Florida
28 Statutes 2001 only through a reviser's bill
29 duly enacted by the Legislature. See s.
30 11.242(5)(b) and (i).

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1 Section 6. Section 240.408, Florida Statutes, is
2 repealed.

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4 Reviser's note.--The cited section, which
5 relates to the Challenger Astronauts Memorial
6 Undergraduate Scholarship Trust Fund, was
7 expressly repealed by s. 15, ch. 99-243, Laws
8 of Florida, effective July 1, 2000. Since the
9 section was not repealed by a "current session"
10 of the Legislature, it may be omitted from the
11 Florida Statutes 2001 only through a reviser's
12 bill duly enacted by the Legislature. See s.
13 11.242(5)(b) and (i).

15 Section 7. Section 290.0075, Florida Statutes, is
16 repealed.

18 Reviser's note.--The cited section, which

20 program, expired pursuant to its own terms,
21 effective June 30, 2000.

23 Section 8. Paragraph (c) of subsection (2) of section
24 290.009, Florida Statutes, is repealed.

26 Reviser's note.--The cited paragraph relates to
27 the provision of assistance in the selection
28 for participation in the enterprise zone linked
29 deposit program pursuant to s. 290.0075.
30 Section 290.0075, which authorized the program,

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1 expired pursuant to s. 29, ch. 94-136, Laws of
2 Florida, effective June 30, 2000.

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4 Section 9. Subsection (3) of section 403.8533, Florida
5 Statutes, is repealed.

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7 Reviser's note.--The cited subsection, which
8 relates to termination of the Drinking Water
9 Revolving Loan Trust Fund, effective July 1,
10 2001, was expressly repealed by s. 2, ch.
11 99-108, Laws of Florida, effective November 4,
12 2000. Since the subsection was not repealed by
13 a "current session" of the Legislature, it may
14 be omitted from the Florida Statutes 2001 only
15 through a reviser's bill duly enacted by the
16 Legislature. See s. 11.242(5)(b) and (i).

18 Section 10. Chapter 442, consisting of ss. 442.001,
19 442.002, 442.003, 442.004, 442.005, 442.006, 442.007, 442.008,
20 442.009, 442.0105, 442.011, 442.012, 442.013, 442.014,
21 442.015, 442.016, 442.017, 442.018, 442.019, 442.020, 442.021,
22 442.022, 442.023, 442.101, 442.102, 442.103, 442.104, 442.105,
23 442.106, 442.107, 442.108, 442.109, 442.111, 442.112, 442.113,
24 442.115, 442.116, 442.118, 442.1185, 442.119, 442.121,
25 442.123, 442.125, 442.126, 442.127, 442.20, and 442.21,
26 Florida Statutes, is repealed.

28 Reviser's note.--The cited chapter, the Florida
29 Occupational Safety and Health Act, was
30 expressly repealed effective July 1, 2000, by
31 s. 14, ch. 99-240, Laws of Florida. Since the

1 chapter was not repealed by a "current session"
2 of the Legislature, it may be omitted from the
3 Florida Statutes 2001 only through a reviser's
4 bill duly enacted by the Legislature. See s.

7 Section 11. Paragraph (d) of subsection (2) of section
8 448.24, Florida Statutes, is repealed.

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10 Reviser's note.--The cited paragraph relates to
11 compliance by labor pools with the requirements
12 of chapter 442. Chapter 442, the Florida
13 Occupational Safety and Health Act, was
14 repealed by s. 14, ch. 99-240, Laws of Florida,
15 effective July 1, 2000.

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17 Section 12. Subsection (3) of section 570.205, Florida
18 Statutes, is repealed.

19
20 Reviser's note.--The cited subsection, which
21 relates to termination of the Federal Law
22 Enforcement Trust Fund under the Department of
23 Agriculture and Consumer Services, effective
24 July 1, 2002, was expressly repealed by s. 2,
25 ch. 99-72, Laws of Florida, effective November
26 4, 2000. Since the subsection was not repealed
27 by a "current session" of the Legislature, it
28 may be omitted from the Florida Statutes 2001
29 only through a reviser's bill duly enacted by
30 the Legislature. See s. 11.242(5)(b) and (i).

2 repealed.
