A bill to be entitled
An act relating to the definition of "political
committee"; amending s. 106.011, F.S.;
modifying the definition of "political
committee"; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (1) of section 106.011, Florida
Statutes, is amended to read:

106.011 Definitions.--As used in this chapter, the
following terms have the following meanings unless the context
clearly indicates otherwise:

(1)(a) "Political committee" means:

1. A combination of two or more individuals, or a
person other than an individual, that, in an aggregate amount
in excess of \$500 during a single calendar year:

a. Accepts contributions for the purpose of making
contributions to any candidate, political committee, committee
of continuous existence, or political party;

b. Accepts contributions for the purpose of expressly
advocating the election or defeat of a candidate or issue;

c. Makes expenditures for the purpose of expressly
advocating the election or defeat of a candidate or issue; or

d. Makes contributions to a common fund, other than a
joint checking account between spouses, from which

contributions are made to any candidate, political committee,
committee of continuous existence, or political party.~~the
primary or incidental purpose of which is to support or oppose
any candidate, issue, or political party, which accepts
contributions or makes expenditures during a calendar year in~~
