A bill to be entitled
An act relating to growth management; providing
that the Legislature intends to enact
legislation to amend chapters 163 and 380,
F.S., relating to the state's system of growth
management; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. It is the intent of the Legislature to
amend chapters 163 and 380, Florida Statutes, to revise the
state's growth management system, including, but not limited
to, providing for streamlined state review of local government
comprehensive plans; providing a rural policy; encouraging
citizen input in comprehensive planning by local governments;
encouraging urban infill and redevelopment; targeting state
infrastructure dollars; modifying the development of the
regional impact process; and defining the appropriate roles of
local, regional, and state government in the state's growth
management system.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
law.
