**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 9, before line 1,

insert:

Section 6. Effective October 1, 2001, section 409.9072, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

409.9072 Medicaid provider agreement for environmental modification services.--Notwithstanding any other provision of law, Medicaid shall enroll any general, building, or residential contractor who is licensed pursuant to chapter 489, as a provider of environmental modification services for any Medicaid home and community-based services waiver program, after such contractor signs the required Medicaid provider agreement. For purposes of this section, "environmental modification services," also known as "environmental accessibility adaptations," means those physical adaptations to the home required by a Medicaid recipient's plan of care that are necessary to ensure the health, safety, and welfare of the recipient or to enable such person to function with
