Senate Amendment

On page 1, lines 14-20, delete those lines

and insert:

Section 1. Effective July 1, 2001, the Board of Pharmacy and the Board of Medicine shall remove any generic named drug product from the formulary established by s. 465.025(6), Florida Statutes, if every commercially marketed equivalent of that drug product is "A" rated as therapeutically equivalent to a reference listed drug or is a referenced listed drug as referred to in "Approved Drug Products with Therapeutic Equivalence Evaluations" (Orange Book) published by the United States Food and Drug Administration.
