Upon such intervention, the Attorney General may obtain any relief that is available to the Attorney General under subsection (17) in a civil action to which that subsection applies.

(17) If the Attorney General has reasonable cause to believe that any person or group of persons is engaged in a pattern or practice of resistance to the full enjoyment of any of the rights secured by the State Constitution or the laws of this state, that any person or group of persons has been denied any of the rights secured by the State Constitution or the laws of this state, or that any person or group of persons has otherwise attempted to interfere with those rights, and such denial or attempted interference raises an issue of general public importance, the Attorney General may commence a civil action in any appropriate state or federal court. In a civil action brought by the Attorney General, the court may award damages or injunctive or other appropriate relief for violations of the rights secured by the State Constitution or the laws of this state and may impose a civil penalty of not more than \$10,000 for each violation. The Attorney General is entitled to reasonable attorney's fees and costs if the Department of Legal Affairs prevails in an action brought under this subsection.
