Section 1. The Department of Environmental Protection, in consultation with representatives of the petroleum industry, shall study the effects and consequences of the use of the gasoline additive methyl tertiary butyl ether (MTBE) in this state, the areas of concern resulting from the use of MTBE, any alternative additives that may be used in place of MTBE, and the effects and consequences of using those alternative additives. The study must take into account the results of the study on MTBE conducted by the Blue Ribbon Panel of the United States Environmental Protection Agency, determine the applicability of the results of that study, and determine actions that should be undertaken in this state. By January 15, 2002, the department shall submit to the Legislature a report containing the results of its study and the department's recommendations for legislation, if any. The Legislature requests that representatives of the petroleum industry participate with the department in the study to the extent practicable.
