If a Regular Class member, the member: 21 a.1. Completes 6 or more years of creditable service 22 and attains age 62; or 23 b.2. Completes 30 years of creditable service, regardless of age, which may include a maximum of 4 years of 24 25 military service credit as long as such credit is not claimed 26 under any other system. 27 2. If a Regular Class member, and the member is 28 employed by a district school board, the member completes 25 29 years of creditable service regardless of age, which may 30 include a maximum of 4 years of military service credit as long as such credit is not claimed under any other system. 31 1
