Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the October 2, 2001, repeal of said section scheduled pursuant to the Open Government Sunset Review Act of 1995, section 539.003, Florida Statutes, is reenacted and amended to read:

(1) All records relating to pawnbroker transactions

539.003 Confidentiality.--

delivered to appropriate law enforcement officials pursuant to s. 539.001 are confidential and exempt from the provisions of s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution and may be used only for official law enforcement purposes. This section does not prohibit the disclosure by the appropriate law enforcement officials of the name and address of the pawnbroker, the name and address of the conveying customer, or a description of pawned property to the alleged owner of pawned property.

(2) This section is subject to the Open Government Sunset Review Act of 1995 in accordance with s. 119.15 and shall stand repealed on October 2, 2001, unless reviewed and saved from repeal through reenactment by the Legislature. Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2001. ********** HOUSE SUMMARY Reenacts the public records exemption for records relating to pawnbroker transactions delivered to appropriate law enforcement officials, and removes the October 2, 2001, repeal thereof scheduled under the Open Government Sunset Review Act of 1995.
