Section 12. Section 641.183, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

641.183 Statutory accounting procedures; transition provisions.--All health maintenance organizations, authorized to do business under this chapter on January 1, 2001, shall elect a transition method for compliance with statutory accounting principles as follows:

(1) Report assets acquired prior to June 30, 2001, in accordance with s. 641.35, Florida Statutes at December 31, 2000, through December 31, 2005. Assets acquired on or after July 1, 2001, shall be accounted for in accordance with the National Association of Insurance Commissioners Accounting Practices and Procedures Manual effective January 1, 2001, and subsequent amendments thereto. 1 organization electing to report assets pursuant to this
2 subsection shall maintain complete and detailed records
3 reflecting such accounting treatment; or

4 (2) Report all assets in accordance with the NAIC

7 Section 13. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
8 law and shall apply retroactively to January 1, 2001.
