A bill to be entitled
An act relating to district school personnel;
amending s. 231.40, F.S.; providing for use of
employees' sick leave by their family members
who also are district employees; providing an
effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (e) is added to subsection (3) of
section 231.40, Florida Statutes, to read:

231.40 Sick leave.--

(3) PROVISIONS GOVERNING SICK LEAVE.--The following
provisions shall govern sick leave:

(e) Use by family member.--Each district school system
must provide a policy under which a district employee may
authorize his or her spouse, child, parent, or sibling who is
also a district employee to use sick leave that has accrued to
the authorizing employee.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2001.

SENATE SUMMARY

Requires school districts to provide a system under which
an employee may allow his or her sick leave to be used by
his or her spouse, child, parent, or sibling, so long as
that relative is also a district employee.
