A bill to be entitled
An act relating to obtaining property by false personation; amending s. 817.02, F.S.; providing that obtaining property by false personation is a second-degree felony; providing penalties; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 817.02, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

817.02 Obtaining property by false personation.--Whoever falsely personates or represents another, and in such assumed character receives any property intended to be delivered to the party so personated, with intent to convert the property ~~the same~~ to his or her own use, commits a felony of the second degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084 ~~shall be punished as if he or she had been convicted of larceny.~~

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2001.

SENATE SUMMARY

Provides that it is a second-degree felony for a person to obtain property by false personation or false representation of another.
