**Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 1, line 20, through page 2, line 3,  
remove from the bill: all of said lines

and insert in lieu thereof:

(a) School districts shall donate on a weekly basis, in accordance with health, safety, and sanitation guidelines, any surplus or excess canned or perishable foods that would otherwise be discarded to food recovery programs, pursuant to s. 570.0725, or to hunger assistance programs provided through community charities or not-for-profit corporations, including faith-based organizations, which provide for the hungry.

(b) Such donations shall be made pursuant to s. 768.136.

(c) School districts in communities with no food recovery or hunger assistance programs are exempt from this subsection.

(d) The State Board of Education shall have the authority to adopt rules pursuant to ss. 120.536(1) and 120.54
