On page 2, line 31, of the bill

after the period insert:

Section 2. No county, municipality, or any other political subdivision of the state may, whether by ordinance, resolution, referendum, initiative, or as a condition of bidding or contracting, or by any other means, require a private employer to pay any employee a minimum wage higher than that required by federal law. If it is determined by the officer or agency responsible or distributing federal funds to the state, or any political subdivision, agency, or instrumentality of the state, that compliance with this section will cause denial of these federal funds or would otherwise be inconsistent with the federal requirements pertaining to such funds, this section shall not apply, but only to the extent necessary to prevent denial of the federal funds or to eliminate the inconsistency with federal
