The Committee on Comprehensive Planning, Local and Military Affairs recommended the following amendment:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 3 between lines 14 and 15,

insert:

Section 4. Notwithstanding any provisions of law to the contrary, the governing body of an inland county with a state-designated enterprise zone and a population greater than 500,000 may apply to the Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development to amend the boundaries of one noncontiguous area of an enterprise zone. The office shall approve the application as long as the amended area does not exceed 4 square miles and is consistent with the categories, criteria, and limitations imposed by section 290.0055, Florida Statutes, upon the establishment of such enterprise zone. The enterprise zone boundary-amendment application must be received before December 31, 2001.
