19	Section 1. Section 290.00694, Florida Statutes, is

22	County or Sarasota County and SarasotaSarasota County, or
23	Sarasota County and the City of Sarasota jointly, may apply to
24	the Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development for
25	designation of one enterprise zone within the county, or
26	within both the county and the municipality, which zone
27	encompasses an area that is south of the north county line,
28	west of Tuttle Avenue, north of 10th Street, and east of U.S.
29	Highway 41. The application must be submitted by December 31,
30	2001, and must comply with the requirements of s. 290.0055.

The Office of Tourism, 4 5 Trade, and Economic Development shall establish the initial б effective date of the enterprise zone designated under this 7 section. 8 Section 2. Section 290.00555, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 9 10 290.00555 Satellite enterprise zones.--Before December 11 31, 1999, Any municipality an area of which has previously received designation as an enterprise zone in the population 12 category described in s. 290.0065(3)(a)3. may create a 13 14 satellite enterprise zone not exceeding 1.5 square miles in area outside of and, notwithstanding anything contained in s. 15 290.0055(4), or any other law, in addition to the previously 16 17 designated enterprise zone boundaries. Section 3. Satellite enterprise zones may be created 26 27 pursuant to section 290.00555, Florida Statutes, effective 28 retroactively to December 31, 1999. Any sales and use taxes 29 paid within such a zone during the period beginning December 31, 1999, and ending on the date of the creation of the zone 30 31 which would have been eligible for the exemptions or credits

granted by sections 212.08(5)(g) and (h) and (15) and 212.096, Florida Statutes, shall be recoverable only as a refund as provided in section 215.26, Florida Statutes. It is the intent of the Legislature that this act be deemed remedial in effect. Section 4. This act shall take effect upon becoming a б law. LEGISLATIVE SUMMARY Authorizes the Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development to designate an enterprise zone in a specified area in Sarasota County and provides requirements with respect thereto. Removes the December 31, 1999, deadline for creation of satellite enterprise zones by certain municipalities and authorizes creation of such zones effective retroactively to that date. Provides for refund of sales and use taxes paid after that date which would have been eligible for certain exemptions or credits exemptions or credits.
