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28	Section 1. Subsection (3) of section 17.43, Florida
29	Statutes, is repealed.
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Reviser's note.--The cited subsection, which 1 2 relates to termination of the Comptroller's 3 Federal Equitable Sharing Trust Fund, effective 4 July 1, 2002, was expressly repealed by s. 2, ch. 99-84, Laws of Florida, effective November 5 4, 2000. Since the subsection was not repealed 6 7 by a "current session" of the Legislature, it 8 may be omitted from the Florida Statutes 2001 9 only through a reviser's bill duly enacted by the Legislature. See s. 11.242(5)(b) and (i). 10 11 12 Section 2. Subsection (3) of section 20.2553, Florida 13 Statutes, is repealed. 14 15 Reviser's note.--The cited subsection, which relates to termination of the Federal Law 16 Enforcement Trust Fund within the Department of 17 Environmental Protection, effective July 1, 18 2002, was expressly repealed by s. 2, ch. 19 20 99-109, Laws of Florida, effective November 4, 21 2000. See s. 11.242(5)(b) and (i). 26 27 Section 3. Section 61.182, Florida Statutes, is 28 repealed. 29 30 Reviser's note.--The cited section, which 31 relates to the Child Support Depository Trust 2

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1 Fund, was expressly repealed by s. 18, ch. 2 99-205, Laws of Florida, effective July 1, 3 2000. Since the section was not repealed by a 4 "current session" of the Legislature, it may be 5 omitted from the Florida Statutes 2001 only through a reviser's bill duly enacted by the 6 7 Legislature. See s. 11.242(5)(b) and (i). 8 9 Section 4. Section 240.3835, Florida Statutes, is 10 repealed. 11 Reviser's note.--The cited section, which 12 13 relates to the Community College Capital 14 Facilities Matching Trust Fund, was expressly 15 repealed by s. 13, ch. 99-243, Laws of Florida, effective July 1, 2000. Since the section was 16 not repealed by a "current session" of the 17 Legislature, it may be omitted from the Florida 18 Statutes 2001 only through a reviser's bill 19 20 duly enacted by the Legislature. See s. 11.242(5)(b) and (i). 21 22 23 Section 5. Section 240.408, Florida Statutes, is 24 repealed. 25 26 Reviser's note.--The cited section, which 27 relates to the Challenger Astronauts Memorial 28 Undergraduate Scholarship Trust Fund, was 29 expressly repealed by s. 15, ch. 99-243, Laws of Florida, effective July 1, 2000. Since the 30 31 section was not repealed by a "current session" 3

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1 of the Legislature, it may be omitted from the 2 Florida Statutes 2001 only through a reviser's 3 bill duly enacted by the Legislature. Section 290.0075, Florida Statutes, is 7 repealed. 8 9 Reviser's note.--The cited section, which relates to the enterprise zone linked deposit 10 11 program, expired pursuant to its own terms, 12 effective June 30, 2000. 13 14 Section 7. Paragraph (c) of subsection (2) of section 15 290.009, Florida Statutes, is repealed. 16 Reviser's note. -- The cited paragraph relates to 17 18 the provision of assistance in the selection for participation in the enterprise zone linked 19 20 deposit program pursuant to s. 290.0075. Section 290.0075, which authorized the program, 21 22 expired pursuant to s. 29, ch. 94-136, Laws of Florida, effective June 30, 2000. 23 24 25 Section 8. Subsection (3) of section 403.8533, Florida 26 Statutes, is repealed. 27 28 Reviser's note.--The cited subsection, which 29 relates to termination of the Drinking Water Revolving Loan Trust Fund, effective July 1, 30 31 2001, was expressly repealed by s. 2, ch. 4

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99-108, Laws of Florida, effective November 4, 1 2 2000. Since the subsection was not repealed by 3 a "current session" of the Legislature, it may be omitted from the Florida Statutes 2001 only 4 5 through a reviser's bill duly enacted by the Legislature.
