Subsection (25) is added to section 409.906, Florida Statutes, to read: 12 13 409.906 Optional Medicaid services. -- Subject to specific appropriations, the agency may make payments for 14 services which are optional to the state under Title XIX of 15 16 the Social Security Act and are furnished by Medicaid 17 providers to recipients who are determined to be eligible on 18 the dates on which the services were provided. Any optional service that is provided shall be provided only when medically 19 necessary and in accordance with state and federal law. 20 21 Nothing in this section shall be construed to prevent or limit the agency from adjusting fees, reimbursement rates, lengths 22 of stay, number of visits, or number of services, or making 23 any other adjustments necessary to comply with the 24 availability of moneys and any limitations or directions 25 26 provided for in the General Appropriations Act or chapter 216. If necessary to safeguard the state's systems of providing 27 28 services to elderly and disabled persons and subject to the notice and review provisions of s. 216.177, the Governor may 29 direct the Agency for Health Care Administration to amend the 30 Medicaid state plan to delete the optional Medicaid service 31 1

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known as "Intermediate Care Facilities for the Developmentally Disabled." Optional services may include: (25) BREAST AND CERVICAL CANCER TREATMENT SERVICES.--The agency may pay for breast and cervical cancer treatment for persons who are eligible for such services under б the federal Breast and Cervical Cancer Prevention and Treatment Act of 2000. Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2001.
