A bill to be entitled 1 2 An act relating to the Department of Transportation; providing for the relief of 3 4 Billie Jo McIntire, Sarah McIntire, and 5 Christian McIntire for the wrongful death of 6 Jeffrey McIntire due to the negligence of the 7 department; providing an effective date. 8 9 WHEREAS, on July 17, 1997, Jeffrey McIntire, a 10 Crestview police officer and husband and father, was driving home on State Road 10 (Highway 90) in Okaloosa County, 11 12 Florida, and WHEREAS, an employee of the Department of 13 14 Transportation, while operating a departmental vehicle and in performance of his duties with the department, was traveling 15 on the same highway at Mosseyhead in Okaloosa County, and 16 17 WHEREAS, it was raining, and the dangerous roadway, bald tires, and high speeds caused the departmental employee 18 19 to violently project his vehicle over the center line and into 20 the path of Jeffrey McIntire, and 21 WHEREAS, a severe crash ensued, and Mr. McIntire died 22 at the scene, and 23 WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation had a responsibility at that time to maintain Highway 90 and to 24 25 safely maintain the vehicles that its employees operated on 26 public highways, and 27 WHEREAS, the employee who was operating the 28 departmental vehicle in the accident was himself responsible for inspecting Highway 90 and other adjacent roadways to 29 30 determine whether safety hazards existed or repairs were 31 | needed, and

WHEREAS, litigation was filed in Okaloosa County for the wrongful death of Jeffrey McIntire, and claims were asserted on behalf of his wife, Billie Jo McIntire, his daughter Sarah, and his son Christian, whose birth was being awaited at the time of his father's fatal accident, and

WHEREAS, before trial, the parties agreed to a stipulated settlement of \$1.2 million, of which \$200,000 has been paid and the \$1 million balance is to be pursued through a claim bill that is affirmatively supported by the Department of Transportation, NOW, THEREFORE,

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. The facts stated in the preamble to this act are found and declared to be true.

The sum of \$1 million is appropriated out Section 2. of funds in the State Treasury to the credit of the Department of Transportation to compensate Billie Jo McIntire, Sarah McIntire, and Christian McIntire for their losses.

Section 3. The Comptroller is directed to draw a warrant in favor of Billie Jo McIntire, as personal representative of the Estate of Jeffery McIntire, in the sum of \$1 million upon funds in the State Treasury to the credit of the Department of Transportation, which funds are for the benefit of Billy Jo McIntire and her minor children Sarah and Christian McIntire, and the Treasurer is directed to pay the same out of such funds. After payment of fees, costs, and authorized expenses, the proceeds under this act shall be equally divided, three ways, among Billie Jo McIntire, Sarah McIntire, and Christian McIntire.
