There shall also be issued 8 9 with each license plate a serially numbered validation sticker 10 showing the year of expiration, which sticker shall be placed on the upper right corner of the license plate. Such license 11 12 plate and validation stickers shall be issued based on the applicant's appropriate renewal period. The registration 13 period shall be a period of 12 months and the extended 14 15 registration period shall be a period of 24 months, and all 16 expirations shall occur based on the applicant's appropriate 17 registration or extended registration period.
