WHEREAS, on Sunday, January 19, 1997, Wieslaw Skowronek was visiting the Virgin Mary apparition at the Seminole Finance Building in Clearwater, Florida, and

WHEREAS, as a result of the use of excessive force by a City of Clearwater policeman, Wieslaw Skowronek's pancreas was ruptured and he bled to death, and

WHEREAS, the death of Wieslaw Skowronek was clearly the consequence of the negligence of the city, and

WHEREAS, the City of Clearwater and Eva Skowronek entered into a settlement agreement in which the city agreed to a settlement in the amount of \$525,000, of which the city would pay \$200,000, Ranger Insurance Company would pay \$125,000, and a claim bill would be submitted for the remaining \$200,000, and

WHEREAS, the City of Clearwater has paid \$200,000, the maximum amount allowable under section 768.28, Florida 31 | Statutes, and the insurance company has paid \$125,000, and

WHEREAS, after payment of attorneys' fees and costs, the court awarded the sum of \$103,896 to Eva Skowronek, and the sum of \$27,965 to be paid to the guardianship account established for Anna Marie Skowronek, the sum of \$27,965 to be paid to the guardianship account established for Victor Skowronek, and the sum of \$27,965 to be paid to the guardianship account established for Hubert Alexander Skowronek, in accordance with sections 732.102 and 732.103, Florida Statutes, which govern the distribution of estate assets for intestate heirs, NOW, THEREFORE,

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. The facts stated in the preamble to this act are found and declared to be true.

Section 2. The City of Clearwater is authorized and directed to appropriate from funds of the city not otherwise appropriated and to draw a warrant in the sum of \$103,896 payable to Eva Skowronek, widow and Personal Representative of the Estate of Wieslaw Skowronek, as compensation for injuries and damages sustained.

Section 3. The City of Clearwater is authorized and directed to appropriate from funds of the city not otherwise appropriated and to draw a warrant in the sum of \$27,965 payable to the guardianship account established for Anna Marie Skowronek, daughter of Wieslaw Skowronek, as compensation for injuries and damages sustained.

Section 4. The City of Clearwater is authorized and directed to appropriate from funds of the city not otherwise appropriated and to draw a warrant in the sum of \$27,965 payable to the guardianship account established for Victor

Skowronek, minor child of Wieslaw Skowronek, as compensation for injuries and damages sustained. Section 5. The City of Clearwater is authorized and directed to appropriate from funds of the city not otherwise appropriated and to draw a warrant in the sum of \$27,965 payable to the guardianship account established for Hubert Alexander Skowronek, minor child of Wieslaw Skowronek, as compensation for injuries and damages sustained. Section 6. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
