24	<u>(d) A proposed amendment or revision that has a fiscal</u>		
25	<u>impact on the state or seeks to raise taxes must be approved</u>		
26	<u>by a vote of at least 60 percent of the electors voting on the</u>		
27	<u>proposed amendment or revision. If approved, the amendment or</u>		
28	<u>revision shall be effective on the first Tuesday after the</u>		
29	<u>first Monday in January following the election, or on such</u>		
30	<u>other date as may be specified in the amendment or revision.</u>

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1 requirements of section 101.161, Florida Statutes, the title  
2 and substance of the amendment proposed herein shall appear on

6                                   APPROVAL OF CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS

7                   Requires approval by 60 percent, rather than a simple  
8 majority, of the electors voting on a proposed constitutional  
9 amendment that has a fiscal impact on the state or seeks to  
10 raise taxes.

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
