If approved, the amendment or revision shall be effective on the first Tuesday after the 28 29 first Monday in January following the election, or on such 30 other date as may be specified in the amendment or revision. 31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in accordance with the 1

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requirements of section 101.161, Florida Statutes, the title and substance of the amendment proposed herein shall appear on the ballot as follows: CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT ARTICLE XI, SECTION 5 APPROVAL OF CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS Requires approval by 60 percent, rather than a simple majority, of the electors voting on a proposed constitutional amendment that has a fiscal impact on the state or seeks to raise taxes.

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
