On page 2, lines 1-15,  
remove from the bill: all of said lines  
and insert in lieu thereof:

(c) If the proposed amendment or revision is approved by vote of the electors, it shall be effective as an amendment to or revision of the constitution of the state on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in January following the election, or on such other date as may be specified in the amendment or revision.

(d) If the proposed amendment or revision requires the state legislature, or other governing body subject to this constitution to appropriate in excess of \$10 million, adjusted for inflation, for costs not associated with administration or enforcement of the amendment, or seeks to raise taxes or fees is approved by a vote of at least 60 percent of the electors voting on the proposed amendment or revision. If approved, the amendment or revision shall be effective on the first

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in accordance with the  
5 requirements of section 101.161, Florida Statutes, the title  
6 and substance of the amendment proposed herein shall appear on  
7 the ballot as follows:

8 APPROVAL OF CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS  
9 Requires approval by 60 percent ~~two-thirds~~, rather than  
10 a simple majority, of the electors voting on a proposed  
11 constitutional amendment that requires the state legislature,  
12 or other governing body subject to this constitution to  
13 appropriate in excess of \$10 million, adjusted for inflation,  
14 for costs not associated with administration or enforcement of  
15 the amendment, or seeks to raise taxes or fees.
