Beach Area of unincorporated Broward County, added as a result of chapter 99-465, Laws of Florida. Section 4. Notwithstanding any general law or special act to the contrary, Lauderdale by the Sea shall have full authority to collect all franchise fees and utility taxes currently being collected by Broward County from the unincorporated area known as Intracoastal Beach Area beginning on the effective date of the annexation, August 15, 2001. Section 5. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
