The employee advisory committee must meet 9 at least quarterly. Suggestions by the employee advisory committee relating to personnel matters must be considered by 10 11 the Authority. The employee advisory committee will be the medium in providing a continuous and meaningful exchange 12 13 between the Authority and employees of ideas regarding and 14 practical solutions to personnel matters. 15 Section 3. Subsection (3) of section 7 of chapter 16 96-449, Laws of Florida, is amended to read: Section 7. ADMISSIONS; INDIGENT CARE .--17 (3) When a resident of Hillsborough County has been 18 19 certified as indigent under criteria established by the Board 20 of County Commissioners of Hillsborough County, the Authority, for each hospital which it operates, shall be reimbursed for 21 22 its services by Hillsborough County an amount equal to the state-approved Medicaid rate plus a standard adjustment. The 23 Authority and the Board of County Commissioners shall, at 24 least once annually, negotiate the standard adjustment, which 25 26 shall include consideration of the actual cost of indigent 27 care when any such hospital is operational. Both the 28 reimbursement rate and the eligibility criteria shall be 29 reviewed and approved at least once annually by the Board of County Commissioners, if any such hospital is operational. 30 31

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Section 4. Section 9 of chapter 96-449, Laws of Florida, is amended to read: Section 9. PARKING AND OFFICE FACILITIES.--Ad valorem taxes may not be used or pledged for revenue or for refunding bonds issued for the construction of parking facilities or б private office facilities. For each hospital operated by the Authority, any office facility must be constructed on premises on or contiguous to the hospital grounds. Section 5. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.

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
