Section 4. The Department of Environmental Protection shall conduct a comprehensive review of the waste reduction and recycling goals set out in part IV of chapter 403, Florida Statutes, and other legislative requirements in view of reduced available funding for these purposes. The review shall include, but is not limited to, the appropriateness of maintaining, extending, or revising the goals; the effectiveness of current programs for meeting the goals; the role of Keep Florida Beautiful, Inc.; the need to continue those programs; alternative techniques for improving those programs; alternative strategies for meeting the needs of the programs; and any other issues related to resource recovery and management. The department shall consult with persons knowledgeable about recycling and waste reduction, including,
