11	conviction, charity without condescension, and emotion with
12	sanity, and
13	WHEREAS, mothers are characterized by unconditional
14	love for their offspring, are slow to lose patience, and serve
15	as the anchors that bond the family, and
16	WHEREAS, a mother's love is like a flame that is always
17	burning but intensifies each time a child is born, and
18	WHEREAS, a mother is a gift bestowed on man, never more
19	dear than when bringing forth life in the form of a child, and
20	WHEREAS, it is proper that the members and staff of the
21	Florida House of Representatives recognize the immeasurable
22	debt of gratitude owed to all mothers for their strength,
23	guidance, understanding, and love, NOW, THEREFORE,

25	Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of
