A bill to be entitled An act relating to compensation of state officials and employees; prescribing the salary rate for specified state officials and employees; providing an expiration date and an effective date. Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida: Notwithstanding any other provision of law Section 1. to the contrary, each state employee whose annual state salary for the 2001-2002 fiscal year exceeds \$90,000 shall be paid for the remainder of that fiscal year at the salary rate for his or her position as it existed on June 30, 2001. In addition, the salary of the Governor, the Lieutenant Governor, the members of the Cabinet, and the heads of all departments of the executive branch shall be that which existed on June This section does not apply to state employees 30, 2001. within the Career Service class or state employees within the classification and pay plan authorized under section 240.209(2)(f), Florida Statutes. Section 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 2002, and expires June 30, 2002. HOUSE SUMMARY For the remainder of the 2001-2002 fiscal year, reduces

For the remainder of the 2001-2002 fiscal year, reduces the salary of each state employee who earns in excess of \$90,000 annually to the salary for that position for the 2000-2001 fiscal year and also reduces the salary of the Governor, the Lieutenant Governor, the members of the Cabinet, and agency heads of the executive branch to that for the 2000-2001 fiscal year. Exempts certain 31 employees. See bill for details.
