This paragraph is subject to the Open Government Sunset Review Act of 1995, in accordance 21 2.2 with s. 119.15, and shall stand repealed on October 2, 2003, 23 unless reviewed and saved from repeal through reenactment by 24 the Legislature. 25 Section 2. The Legislature finds that the exemption 26 from public records requirements provided by this act is a 27 public necessity because law enforcement officers or former 28 law enforcement officers can be identified as such by 29 connecting them with their cellular telephone numbers that are 30 used in the course of their employment. The identification of current and former law enforcement officers through cellular 31

telephone numbers can compromise investigations, undermine those officers' ability to apprehend suspects, and compromise the physical safety of law enforcement officers. Consequently, the Legislature finds that cellular telephone numbers of law enforcement officers and former law enforcement officers that б are used in the course of their employment must be kept confidential. Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law. LEGISLATIVE SUMMARY Provides an exemption from public records requirements for the cellular telephone numbers of current and former law enforcement officers. Provides a statement of public necessity and for future review and repeal of the exemption.
