A bill to be entitled

An act relating to student withdrawal from courses due to military service; requiring rules by district school boards, community college district boards of trustees, and university boards of trustees; providing that a student shall not suffer academic or financial penalties; authorizing the refund of fees; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Each district school board, community college district board of trustees, and university board of trustees shall establish, by rule and pursuant to guidelines of the Florida Board of Education, policies regarding the withdrawal from courses and refund of any matriculation and fees paid by a student who withdraws or drops one or more courses due to call to or enlistment in active military service. Such policies shall provide that no student enrolled in a postsecondary course or courses at an area technical center, a public community college, a public college, or a state university shall suffer academic or financial penalties by virtue of performing military service on behalf of our country. A student shall be permitted the option of either completing the course or courses at a later date without penalty or withdrawing from the course or courses with a full refund of fees paid. If the student chooses to withdraw, the student's record shall reflect that the withdrawal is due to active military service.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law. HOUSE SUMMARY Requires rules by district school boards, community college district boards of trustees, and university boards of trustees relating to student withdrawal from courses due to call to or enlistment in active military service. Provides that academic or financial penalties shall not be applied.
