295.0185 Children of deceased or disabled military personnel who died or became disabled in Operation Enduring Freedom; educational opportunity. --

(1) It is hereby declared to be the policy of the state to provide educational opportunity at state expense for the dependent children of those military personnel who died or suffered a service-connected 100-percent total and permanent disability rating for compensation as determined by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs, or who have been determined to have a service-connected total and permanent disability rating of 100 percent and are in receipt of disability retirement pay from any branch of the United States

Armed Services, while participating in Operation Enduring 1 Freedom, which began on October 7, 2001, if such military 2 3 personnel were residents of the the state during the period of military action. A certified copy of a death certificate, a 4 valid identification card issued in accordance with the 5 provisions of s. 295.17, a letter certifying the 6 7 service-connected 100-percent total and permanent disability 8 rating for compensation from the United States Department of 9 Veterans Affairs, or a letter certifying the service-connected total and permanent disability rating of 100 percent for 10 11 retirement pay from any branch of the United States Armed Services shall be prima facie evidence of the fact that the 12 13 dependent children of such military personnel are eligible for 14 educational benefits. 15 (2) The provisions of ss. 240.404, 295.03, 295.04, and 16 295.05 shall apply. 17 Section 2.
