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(a) Declare as a pest any form of plant or animal life 1 2 or virus which is injurious to plants, humans, domestic 3 animals, articles, or substances. 4 (b) Establish procedures for the taking and handling 5 of samples and establish tolerances and deficiencies where not 6 specifically provided for in this chapter; assess penalties; 7 and prohibit the sale or use of pesticides or devices shown to 8 be detrimental to human beings, the environment, or 9 agriculture or to be otherwise of questionable value. (c) Determine whether pesticides, and quantities of 10 substances contained in pesticides, are injurious to the 11 12 environment. The Office of Program Policy Analysis and Government Accountability is directed to review the cost impact to the aerial-application industry of the implementation of any rules adopted by the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services pursuant to this act and report its findings to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives by January 1, 2003.
