**Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 9, line 12 of the bill

insert:

Section 10. In order to implement the provisions of the act making appropriations and reductions in appropriations for the 2001-2002 state fiscal year and notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, all agency heads are hereby authorized to renegotiate current state contracts with private providers and public/providers to reduce contract payments up to five percent as long as vital education, health care, and public safety services are not reduced. The statewide goal is \$75 million in savings that will be redirected, proportionately, into the current year education, health care, and public safety budget cuts. This section expires July 1, 2002.
