A bill to be entitled

An act to stimulate the economy; providing legislative findings of economic hardship stemming from the terrorist attacks against the United States; expressing the intent of the Legislature to enact policies to stimulate economic activity in the state; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. The Legislature finds that, in the aftermath of the September 11, 2001, terrorist attacks against the United States, businesses and individuals in this state are experiencing significant economic hardship and revenues critical to the delivery of vital public services are jeopardized. It is, therefore, the intent of the Legislature to enact policies designed to stimulate economic activity in the state and promote the economic security of its residents.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.

SENATE SUMMARY

Expresses the legislative intent to enact policies to stimulate economic activity and to promote economic security.
