Current employees of private vendors operating 14 15 correctional facilities shall receive first preference for 16 employment by the Department of Corrections; provided, 17 however, that Correctional Officers currently employed by 18 private vendors must meet the minimum qualifications for 19 employment specific in section 943.13, Florida Statutes.
